

# General Track Rules

## Talladega Gran Prix Raceway

1. No loud or racing engines to be run before 8 AM (CT) or after 5 PM (CT) Monday-Sunday (Quiet Time) and 11:00 AM-12:00 Noon (CT) lunch break on Sundays
2. No loud noises after 11pm to include music and engines
3. No open pipes
4. Vehicles will be allowed on track only while an ambulance is standing by and ready to respond immediately, during events requiring an ambulance.
5. No alcohol consumption during the hot track hours of 8:00 AM (CT)-5:00 PM (CT)
6. No pets allowed in any buildings
7. All pets must be on a leash at all times
8. No standing or sitting on the hot pit wall
9. No loitering on the hot pit road
10. All children must be supervised at all times
11. No children under 16 years of age on the hot pit road during hot track hours
12. Post no bills on any surface with the exception of designated bulletin boards.
13. Speed limit in the pit and paddock area is 10 MPH
14. No burnouts, spinning tires, or throwing stones in the paddock area
15. The Lessee will be responsible for any damage to the track surface or facility in any manner.
16. Only vehicles of comparable performance on the track at the same time.
17. No refueling or oil changing on any asphalt surface.
18. Any oil or fuel spill must be cleaned immediately.
19. Any vehicle with any fluid leaks will not be allowed on the track surface until repaired.
20. The Lessee is responsible for all medical services
21. K&K Insurance waivers must be used. Any additional waivers must have prior approval.
22. Property must be vacated by 7:00 PM (CT) on the last day of the contracted event.
23. Lessee will provide a minimum of 1-hour lunch break for the ambulance and safety crew.
24. No motorized vehicle allowed on the track after hot track hours.
25. The race track will be one-way traffic at all times
26. Lessee will be responsible to supply an acceptable number of corner worker as per type of event.
27. All pit bike and ATV riders will wear a helmet.
28. All rider/drivers will wear proper helmet, racing suits, boots, and gloves designed for high performance riding/driving.
29. Lessee will be responsible to define and enforce adequate vehicle technical standards for high performance driving/riding.
30. Authorized personnel only in starter's stand.
31. **The Lessee shall also be responsible to provide corner workers for their event. Need for corners workers will be based on event type.** If Lessee declines this service, additional risk is assumed by Lessee.
  - a. **Motorcycle events:**
    - Non-Competition events (1-6 riders): minimum two (2) corner workers optional but recommended
    - Non-Competition events (over 6 riders): minimum three (3) corner workers optional but recommended
    - Competition events (any number of riders): full crew of eleven (9-11) corner workers required
  - b. **Auto events:**
    - Non-Competition events (1-6 drivers): minimum three (3) corner workers optional but recommended
    - Non-Competition events (over 6 drivers): minimum four (4) corner workers optional but recommended
    - Competition events (any number of drivers): full crew (9-11) corner workers required

32. **Ambulance unit(s) are highly recommended.** If Lessee declines this service, additional risk is assumed by Lessee. TGPR will arrange ambulance unit(s) at the request of Lessee. BLS (Basic Life Support) or ALS (Advanced Life Support) is available based on event type.

**a. Motorcycle events:**

- Non-Competition events: minimum one (1) BLS unit is required
- Competition events: minimum one (1) ALS unit is required

**b. Auto events:**

- Non-Competition events: minimum one (1) BLS optional but recommended
- Competition events: minimum one (1) BLS required

Auto specific rules:

1. All autos using the track will keep all four wheels on the asphalt at all times. Dropping wheels off the pavement at the entrance, apex, or exit of the turns will not be permitted.
  - a. First time any wheels are dropped off the pavement the offending driver is to return to pit out for instructions and the offending driver loses passenger privilege.
  - b. Repeated dropping of wheels off the pavement may result in loss of driving privileges.
2. Drifting is not allowed.

All rules listed above will be subject to interpretation, enforcement and/or modification by the track management. Violation of these rules may result in cancellation of this agreement with no refund.
